## Linguistic Mechanisms in Dream Interpretation according to Sigmund Freud and Carl Gustav Jung

The article focuses on certain "points of contact" between the theories of dream interpretation developed by Sigmund Freud and Carl Gustav Jung and modern cognitive linguistics. The author underlines the relevance of linguistic transformations such as metaphor, metonymy, symbolization, paronymy, homonymy, paronomasia, and associative networks for Freud's theory.
