(Summary)

The article focusses on the clarification of the mechanisms by which the participants in the European Transplant Games 2024 build a community and construct their identity. Through the prism of the anthropological approach, and basing herself on autobiographical interviews, the author analyses the active role of these participants in maintaining and popularizing problems related to donation and transplantation. Transplants participate in non-governmental organizations, in state commissions and public councils to achieve lasting results for their cause. At the same time, sport is an essential part of their lives, it energizes them and gives them strength to continue their social activities.
